CAR TRIPS

- Make sure car trips are always safe, relaxed and comfortable
- Take your pet to other places instead of just the vet.

COME IN AND SAY HELLO

- Even when you don't have an appointment
- The friendly staff will welcome you and give your pet a treat



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IF YOU HAVE A REACTIVE OR ENERGETIC DOG

- Make your appointment in the middle of the day.
- Dogs are more active in the late morning and afternoon

ADAPTIL AND FELIWAY

- A bandanna sprayed with Adaptil may help your dog feel less stressed
- Help your cat too by spraying Feliway in their carrier



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TAKE CARE IN RECEPTION

- Other dogs and cats may be unwell, in pain or anxious
- Keep your dog away from other pets

IF IT FEELS SAFER, KEEP YOUR PET IN THE CAR

- Bypass reception if you can for a stress free visit
- Keep the car well ventilated if it is hot



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TAKE GREAT TREATS

- Small, soft, scrumptious and safe
- Food makes you feel good
- To feel at ease, treats can help

PUT YOUR PET BEHIND A BARRIER

- Help your pet feel safe in reception
- Sit behind a barrier or in a separate area



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STAY CALM

- Remain calm
- If you are calm, it will help your pet remain calm

KEEP YOUR CAT IN IT'S CARRIER

- Cover with a towel sprayed with the feline pheromone Feliway
- Place on a chair with the door facing away from other pets
